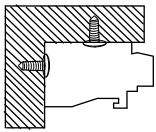


## Roman Blind Cord Operated Fitting Instructions

Your made to measure Roman blind is supplied complete and ready to hang on the brackets supplied.

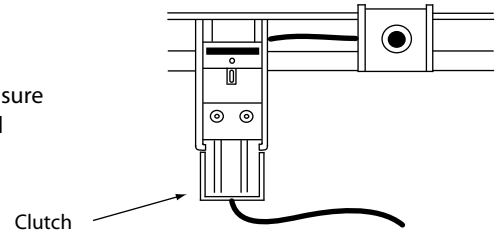
### 1. Fixing your blind

The brackets are designed to be used as either top fix (top of the Window recess or ceiling) or face fix (wall or window frame).



In order to provide the stability for fixing or removing the rail it is essential that the brackets are fixed securely. When fixing the brackets you must ensure that they do not coincide with the position of the cord guides. Use a metal tape measure to show where the cord guides will be positioned before marking the location of the brackets.

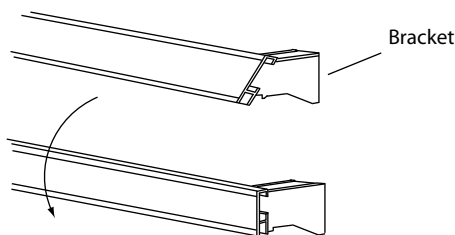
Ensure that the brackets at each end are fixed as close to the end of the rail as possible.



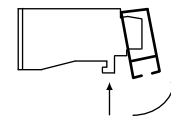
### 2. Before fixing the brackets consider the following

The upper lip of the Velcro<sup>®</sup> rail will be mounted from the top of the bracket. Insert the upper lip of the Velcro<sup>®</sup> rail profile and snap that rail onto the brackets. For wide or heavy blinds it is easier to start with the central bracket and work outwards.

#### To attach the rail



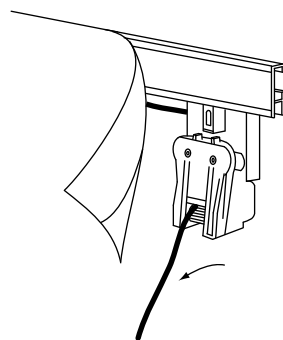
#### To detach the rail



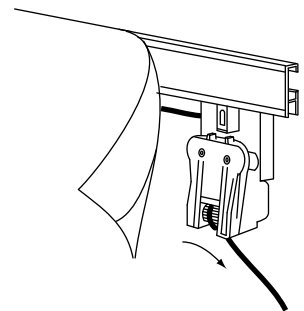
Removal push upwards and forwards

### 3. To position your blind

Pull the cord towards you to release the blind. Move up and down as required still holding cord towards you.



To secure the blind move the cord towards the window and ease the pressure slightly.



### 4. Cleaning instructions

We recommend that you dry clean your Roman blind, especially when lined as washing may cause differential shrinkage between the fabric and the lining.
